

G1W2 Walk -

Go over zebra crossing, and along Cookworthy Rd.

Cross at lights, and go up Higher Union Rd and straight on through Homeland's Place and beside Treble

Railway Arch

This is the 3rd bridge out from Kingsbridge Station. The line was complete in 1893 and spanned 12 miles from its branch at Brent Station. There were 4 stations - Avonwick, Gara Bridge, Loddiswell/Woodleigh and Kingsbridge-, 48 bridges, a 640 yd tunnel at Sorley and crossed the River Avon in 10 places.

It was single track, with a crossing point beyond Loddiswell - so, the right hand set of rails are misleading. The arches each side of the main arch are for strength and foot access.

The signals show level for stop and up for clear.

Passenger service ended in Sept 1963, under the Beeching cuts and negotiations to save it were aborted 3 months later.

Look on top of the bridge at drop behind where the railway line went

Go over bridge (Old Plymouth Rd) and return via Cookworthy Rd and Devon Square
